

Recycling

No wishful recycling, please. If in doubt, down the chute to the landfill.

The following items go into mixed recycling for roller bins and the commingle dumpster that are picked up by Sanipac:

- **newspapers**
- **junk mail**
- **business mail**
- **pulp paper**
- **magazines**
- **cardboard boxes**
- **aluminum and tin containers**
- **foil balls**
- **pie plates**
- **#1 and #2 plastic bottles, jars and tubs (no other shapes or numbers)**
- **plastic should be clean and dry**

The following items may NOT go into the bin or dumpster. They go to the trash:

- **lids or pumps**
- **tubs**
- **no other numbers besides those listed above**
- **take-out containers**
- **plastic bags**
- **paper milk or juice cartons**
- **butter cartons**
- **prescription bottles.**

Glass bottles and jars:

- Place in paper bags in chute rooms or in roller bin in recycle room. (Empty, clean, dry).
- No broken glass or window glass.

Tubs, bottles and jugs #2, #4, and #5 taken to Lane County Waste Management:

- Sort by number and place in appropriate black bin in recycle room at ground level trash room. They should be empty, clean, dry. No adhesive labels or decals and no lids.

Composting

A roller bin is provided for organic yard and kitchen waste, located during summer (fruit fly) season in the east parking lot, and in cooler weather in the recycle room at ground level on the south side.

The following items are suitable for the compost bin:

- **compostable organic material only**
- **animal bones okay**
- **root balls with soil shaken off**

The following items may NOT go into the compost:

- **plastics**
- **soil**
- **pet waste**

The bin is emptied twice a month by our waste collection service.
